22.07.2022 Mobility:

Journey to Belgrade

At the moment there is no train connection to Belgrade. A direct train connection between Budapest and Belgrade is expected to open in 2024. The long-distance buses do not take bicycles. Therefore the best way to get there is by plane.

24.08.2021 Routing:

Map B27

Cycle route closed between Popina and Vetren.

Waypoint 39: Turn right on the road 211. When you reach the main road 21 turn left. In Srebarna you will rejoin the Danube Bike Trail.

26.01.2024 General Information:

Return journey from Tulcea or Constanta

It is currently not possible to return by train with your bicycle between Tulcea and Bucharest (unfortunately, the Romanian state railway service is constantly changing).

You can travel with your bike by the following private railway companies:

www.regionalatori.ro: Direct train from Constanta to Bucharest (journey time: 3 hours)

www.transferoviarcalatori.ro: Direct train from Feteti to Bucharest (journey time: 2.5 hours)

Bus companies will take bikes if they are dismantled and packed.

Border crossing-point from Serbia to Bulgaria

Due to the order from the Bulgarian ministry of Health, it is not possible for cyclists to cross the border in Bregovo. You have to cycle 40 more kilometers over Zajear.
